

## **Guidelines for Appropriate Dress**

Students at Linscott are expected to dress in a manner that is appropriate for a learning environment. The following guidelines are presented to assist students and parents in making responsible, respectful and responsive choices.

**\*Skirts and shorts must reach the tips of the fingers when arms are held straight along the wearer's side.**

**\*The midriff section must be covered. Shirts, tops, etc. must touch the waistband of the pants or skirts.**

**\*No spaghetti straps. Tank tops should have straps at least two fingers in width.**

**\*Shoes should be a reasonable height. No overly high heels or platforms. No flip flops or Uggs in P.E. class.**

**\*Pants must cover underwear. Boys "jersey-style" sleeveless shirts must have a sleeved shirt underneath.**

**\*No clothing with inappropriate logos – no advertising for alcohol, drugs, discriminatory/offensive messages, etc.**

**\*Caps, hats, beanies and hoods may be worn outside, but are not allowed in the classroom.**

**\*Due to safety concerns, shoes with "built-in wheels" are not to be worn during school hours.**

**\*Field Trips may require specific kinds of clothing, i.e. hiking shoes, rain gear.**

**\*Pajamas and costumes are only allowed on special days when that attire is appropriate.**

**\*\* *Additional restrictions on dress may be imposed (example: colors, style) as necessary.***
